11 Day – Johannesburg to Mpumalanga, Durban and Cape Town

Day 1: Johannesburg

Arrive on an early flight at O R Tambo, Johannesburg. Proceed to the coach waiting for your onward transfer via a Johannesburg City Tour. Check in at your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Lunch and dinner for own account on all days.

Day 2: Johannesburg to Mpumalanga

After breakfast, depart to Mpumalanga and travel along the Panorama route with its breath taking views: The Blyde River Canyon, third largest in the world, is protected by a 26 000 ha nature reserve. This canyon was gauged from the earth's crust by die humble Blyde River over a period of 60 million years. There are superb views, with the finest of them overlooking The Three Rondavels.

Bourke's Luck Potholes is the confluence of the Blyde and Treur Rivers, a dramatic landscape of strange pools and cauldrons of rock where man's history can be traced back for millions of years.

God's Window is so called for its stunning views of the Lowveld more than 900 metres below.

Overnight at Hotel adjacent to Kruger National Park.

Day 3: Mpumalanga Kruger National Park

Depart hotel for early morning Game safari in open safari vehicle for game viewing. You are sure to see the Big Five during this exciting drive.

Breakfast packs will be provided.

Lunch to be served at one of the main camps in Kruger Park for own account. Proceed with Safari and return to hotel, late afternoon.

Day 4: Mpumalanga to Johannesburg

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and return to Johannesburg. Lunch on route for own account. Check in at Hotel, late afternoon and spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure.

Day 5: Johannesburg to Cape Town

After breakfast at Hotel, depart to airport for early flight to George Airport in the Western Cape. Book into a hotel in Knysna, and take a boat trip on the Knysna Lagoon with sunset cocktails.

Day 6: Knysna

After breakfast at hotel, travel to Storms River in the Tsitsikamma National Park, Via Plettenberg Bay. On the way you will cross the Bloukrans Bridge which has one of the worlds' highest Bungee jumping facilities. At Storms River you can take a boat trip into the natural lakes and gorges of this magnificent area.

Late afternoon return to Knysna and your hotel.

Day 7: Garden Route to Cape Town

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and drive to Cape Town along the picturesque Garden Route. Embark on a winelands tour at one of the wine farms in the vicinity of Cape Town. Proceed to Cape Town book into Hotel in the city or on the famous V&A Waterfront.

Day 8: Cape Town

After breakfast at hotel embark on Cape Town City orientation tour, where you will drive past Castle of Good Hope, Parliament estate, Tuinhuis and St George's Cathedral.

Thereafter visit Table Mountain where, weather permitting, you may take a Cable car up the mountain for a 360 degree panoramic view of the Mother City.

Proceed to V&A Waterfront for lunch and some shopping.

Transfer back to your hotel.

Day 9: Cape Town

After breakfast, embark on a full day Cape Peninsula Tour.

Travel to a fishing village of Hout Bay for a 45 minute Seal Island cruise and visit boulders beach penguin colony.

Lunch can be enjoyed at the fishermans village of FISH HOEK, and then you proceed to Chapman's Peak Drive and Cape Point Nature Reserve

Late afternoon, return to hotel.

Day 10: Cape Town to Johannesburg

After breakfast, transfer to Cape Town Airport for departure to O R Tambo.

IMPORTANT to note:

Guidelines for Tours to Southern Africa include the following:

Luggage:

- Preferably one large kit bag (max 20 kg/44LBS)
- Should you bring hard suitcases limit to max 20kg/44 lbs
- One item of hand luggage (eg small backpack)

Items to remember for African Safari:

- Valid passport (at least 6 months longer than date of arrival)
- Torch with spare batteries
- Sunhat/cap, bathing costume, sunscreen
- · Warm jacket and neutral colored clothing
- Comfortable hiking shoes and sandals
- Photographic equipment, binoculars, spare memory cards and batteries
- Water bottle
- Malaria prophylaxis and mosquito repellent.

Travel Insurance (Compulsory)

All travelers booking a safari to Southern Africa must have adequate medical insurance. Dietary requirements:

Visas:

PLEASE NOTE: Should the tour you are joining be re-entering a country, be sure to have a multiple entry visa that enables you to re-enter the country.

You should also have proof of sufficient funds (e.g. credit card) to see you through your time in the country.
