3 Day Eswatini (Swaziland) Experience

Day 1: O R TAMBO/ JHB to Swaziland

Swaziland, also known as Eswatini, is a small country within the borders of South Africa, with a big heart and warm, friendly people: the kingdom embraces its unique and ancient traditions, whilst guarding and celebrating them. Swazi people are a single ethnic group comprising of several clans, united under one monarch. The Swazi character is one of friendliness and kindness, always enquiring after each others' wellbeing when greeting each other.

With the exception of desert and sea, every geographical feature of Africa's landscape is found within Swaziland: magnificent mountain scenery with rivers, waterfalls and gorges; unique rock formations and typical African bush.

After an early departure from your hotel/accommodation/airport, we will make our way through the Highveld with all its agricultural farms and coal mining areas through the Drakensberg Mountains to the Lowveld area entering Swaziland via the N4 National Road.

We will be making stops on route to stretch legs and enjoy a quick lunch for own account

Afternoon check into Hotel/Lodge and enjoy the Hotel amenities at leisure. Dinner (own account)

Day 2 & 3: Swaziland

Aftre breakfast we leave the hotel and start the exploration of Swaziland.

We will visit very interesting Swazi cultural destinations such as the Ngwenya Glass Factory and the Swazi Candle factory.

During the afternoon, we visit the Matenga Falls cultural village - this is a full homestead of the Swazi Nation to see how they live and their traditions. We will see a beautiful waterfall and also attend a cultural dance display. We return to the lodge/hotel late afternoon, and spend the afternoon and evening at leisure.

Day 4: Swaziland to Johannesburg

After early morning breakfast, depart the hotel and make our way back to Johannesburg.

Stops will be done on route, as well as for lunch (own account)

We will arrive in Johannesburg late afternoon and be taken to your accommodation or the airport for your flight home. This is where we bid you farewell.

IMPORTANT to note:

Guidelines for Tours to Southern Africa include the following:

Luggage:

- Preferably one large kit bag (max 20 kg/44LBS)
- Should you bring hard suitcases limit to max 20kg/44 lbs
- One item of hand luggage (eg small backpack)

Items to remember for African Safari:

- Valid passport (at least 6 months longer than date of arrival)
- Torch with spare batteries
- Sunhat/cap, bathing costume, sunscreen
- Warm jacket and neutral colored clothing
- Comfortable hiking shoes and sandals
- Photographic equipment, binoculars, spare memory cards and batteries
- Water bottle
- Malaria prophylaxis and mosquito repellent.

Travel Insurance (Compulsory)

All travelers booking a safari to Southern Africa must have adequate medical insurance. Dietary requirements:

Visas:
