3 Day Classic Kruger Park Safari

Day 1: O R TAMBO/ JHB to Kruger National Park

After an early departure from your hotel/accommodation/airport, we will make our way through the Highveld and Drakensberg Mountains to the Lowveld via Nelspruit to Hazyview next to the Kruger National Park.

We will be making a quick stop on route to stretch legs and enjoy a quick lunch for own account, before we continue to our lodge/hotel. On route you will see a showcase of the finest Mountain ranges and farmlands that South Africa's Lowveld has to offer.

Afternoon check into Hotel/Lodge near the park and enjoy the afternoon next to the pool or in your room before partaking in an open vehicle sunset game drive. Return to hotel/lodge for dinner (own account)

Day 2: Safari in Kruger National Park

Early departure for full day Kruger National park experience with breakfast packs which will be enjoyed mid morning at a picnic spot in the Park. A local guide will accompany you the whole day in an open 4x4 safari vehicle, where you will enjoy game viewing to sight the BIG FIVE and different species of antelope and birds. Note that it is not guaranteed that you will spot all 5 species from the BIG FIVE, as the Leopard can be quite illusive during the day.

Lunch is for your own account and can be enjoyed at one of the several rest camps in the Park, after which the game viewing will continue.

We return to the lodge/hotel at around 15h30.

Day 3: Kruger National Park, via Panorama Route to Johannesburg

After early morning breakfast, depart for a visit to the beautiful Panorama Route. This route includes the majestic views of God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes, Three Rondavels and the Blyde River canyon. We then continue our journey to Johannesburg, passing through the towns of Ohrigstad and Lydenburg, and stop again in Dullstroom for a quick lunch (own account).

We will arrive in Johannesburg late afternoon and be taken to your accommodation or the airport for your flight home. This is where we bid you farewell.

IMPORTANT to note:

Guidelines for Tours to Southern Africa include the following:

Luggage:

- Preferably one large kit bag (max 20 kg/44LBS)
- Should you bring hard suitcases – limit to max 20kg/44 lbs
- One item of hand luggage (eg small backpack)

Items to remember for African Safari:

- Valid passport (at least 6 months longer than date of arrival)
- Torch with spare batteries
- Sunhat/cap, bathing costume, sunscreen
- Warm jacket and neutral colored clothing
- Comfortable hiking shoes and sandals
- Photographic equipment, binoculars, spare memory cards and batteries
- Water bottle
- Malaria prophylaxis and mosquito repellent.

Please read through before arriving in South Africa for your safari. You are welcome to contact Sunstreak Tours should you have any queries.

Travel Insurance (Compulsory)

All travelers booking a safari to Southern Africa must have adequate medical insurance. This is compulsory as activity providers on safari may refuse participation of activities without proper insurance in place. Should you not have medical insurance you may be required to pay cash before being airlifted should this become necessary.

General Health

Please note that we need to be informed of any pre-existing health conditions such as diabetes or asthma or any other condition that requires prescription medicine. Please note that Sunstreak Tours or any of its travel partners will not be held liable or responsible for damage or loss to such medication and the safe-keeping of such medication must be looked after by its respective user. Note that no provision is made on this tour for persons with walking disabilities or wheelchairs.

Dietary requirements:

In order for Sunstreak Tours and its travel partners to properly cater whilst on tour, it is important to inform us at the point of booking should there be any special dietary requirement.

Visas:

As visa requirements vary considerably from country to country and nationality to nationality, please contact the various embassies or a visa service agent in your home country to re-check your visa requirements at least 4 weeks prior to travelling.

Please note that visas are the responsibility of the traveler and that Sunstreak Tours or its partners will not be held responsible for guests being denied entry should they not be in the possession of the relevant visas.

PLEASE NOTE: Should the tour you are joining be re-entering a country, be sure to have a multiple entry visa that enables you to re-enter the country.

All travelers must be in possession of a valid onward/return air ticket or proof of other means of transport enabling the traveler to leave the country in which your tour passes or terminates. You should also have proof of sufficient funds (e.g. credit card) to see you through your time in the country.
