5 Day Panorama, Kruger and Eswatinin(Swaziland) Experience

Day 1: O R TAMBO/ JHB to Kruger Park via Panorama Route

After an early departure from your hotel/accommodation/airport, we will travel to the Mpumalanga Province, known as "Paradise Country" to the Panorama Route, stopping along the way for a quick lunch. (Own account)

We will visit Bourkes Luck Potholes, some waterfalls the Blyde River Canyon and Gods Window. We will also see Three Rondavels which is huge spiraling mountaintop sculptures resembling pointed roofs of traditional African homesteads.

We will then continue to your lodge/hotel where you will enjoy dinner for own account.

Day 2: Kruger National Park

You will have an early rise to get ready for a thrilling experience in the Kruger Park, in an open 4x4 safari vehicle. Early morning is an optimal time to ensure the best game viewing in this Park which is bigger than the state of Connecticut. The packed breakfasts can be enjoyed at one of the picnic spots in the Park.

You will perhaps have a chance to see all of the Big Five, namely the Lion, the Elephant, The Rhino, The Leopard and the Cape Buffalo. You will also see lots of other species and of the 500 Bird species. Lunch will be enjoyed in the park at one of the many camps. (Own account) After lunch you proceed with your safari

Late afternoon, you will return to the hotel for dinner (own account)

Day 3: Kruger to Swaziland

After early morning breakfast, depart the hotel and make our way to Swaziland, and independent kingdom within the borders of South Africa, known for its wonderful scenery, fine handcrafts and vibrant indigenous culture.

Stops will be done on route, as well as for lunch (own account)

We will arrive in Swaziland later that afternoon, where the rest of the day can be spent at leisure, after checking into your hotel/lodge.

Day 4: Swaziland

After early morning breakfast, depart the hotel and make our way to the Ngwenya Glass factory where you can enjoy watching glass blowers form enchanting African animals, birds and fish from 100% recycled glass.

Later we will also do a visit to the Swazi Candle factory to see wax artists creating beautiful candles in all sorts of shapes and sizes.

Later in the afternoon, we will visit the Montenga Cultural village where you will see a complete Swazi homestead, depicting the Swazi's way of life.

We will then return to the hotel/lodge for dinner (own account). Rest of evening will be at leisure.

Day 5: Swaziland to Johannesburg

After early morning breakfast, depart the hotel and make our way back to Johannesburg.

Stops will be done on route, as well as for lunch (own account)

We will arrive in Johannesburg late afternoon and be taken to your accommodation or the airport for your flight home. This is where we bid you farewell.

IMPORTANT to note:

Guidelines for Tours to Southern Africa include the following:

Luggage:

- Preferably one large kit bag (max 20 kg/44LBS)
- Should you bring hard suitcases limit to max 20kg/44 lbs
- One item of hand luggage (e.g. small backpack)

Items to remember for African Safari:

- Valid passport (at least 6 months longer than date of arrival)
- Torch with spare batteries
- Sunhat/cap, bathing costume, sunscreen
- Warm jacket and neutral colored clothing
- Comfortable hiking shoes and sandals
- Photographic equipment, binoculars, spare memory cards and batteries
- Water bottle
- Malaria prophylaxis and mosquito repellent.

Please read through before arriving in South Africa for your safari. You are welcome to contact Sunstreak Tours should you have any queries.

Travel Insurance (Compulsory)

All travelers booking a safari to Southern Africa must have adequate medical insurance. This is compulsory as activity providers on safari may refuse participation of activities without proper insurance in place. Should you not have medical insurance you may be required to pay cash before being airlifted should this become necessary.

General Health

Please note that we need to be informed of any pre-existing health conditions such as diabetes or asthma or any other condition that requires prescription medicine. Please note that Sunstreak Tours or any of its travel partners will not be held liable or responsible for damage or loss to such medication and the safe-keeping of such medication must be looked after by its respective user. Note that no provision is made on this tour for persons with walking disabilities or wheelchairs.

Dietary requirements:

In order for Sunstreak Tours and its travel partners to properly cater whilst on tour, it is important to inform us at the point of booking should there be any special dietary requirement.

Visas:

As visa requirements vary considerably from country to country and nationality to nationality, please contact the various embassies or a visa service agent in your home country to re-check your visa requirements at least 4 weeks prior to travelling.

Please note that visas are the responsibility of the traveler and that Sunstreak Tours or its partners will not be held responsible for guests being denied entry should they not be in the possession of the relevant visas.

PLEASE NOTE: Should the tour you are joining be re-entering a country, be sure to have a multiple entry visa that enables you to re-enter the country.

All travelers must be in possession of a valid onward/return air ticket or proof of other means of transport enabling the traveler to leave the country in which your tour passes or terminates. You should also have proof of sufficient funds (e.g. credit card) to see you through your time in the country.
